#### **YOUTH MUST...**

- Be 10 - 17 years of age
- Reside in one of the following zip codes:  
48205, 48207, 48211, 48213, 48214, 48215  
48224, 48234
- Parent/Guardian consent required

#### **BEHAVIORS: (must demonstrate at least 2)**

1. Experienced truancy from home
2. School truancy, suspensions/expulsions
3. Alcohol tobacco or drug use
4. Unruly behavior in home/community
5. Has non law abiding peer relationships
6. Academic difficulty
7. Bullying Behavior
